



CRITERIA FOR 2021 INTERNATIONAL EVENT SELECTION – MEN AND WOMEN

Golf Canada is carefully following the evolution of COVID-19 and how it may impact selection for international teams. Golf Canada has modified selection criteria specifically for 2021 to account for the impact of COVID-19, and reserves the right to modify the selection criteria further if circumstances continue to change because of the pandemic. Any modifications will be promptly communicated. For 2022 and beyond, once the impact of the pandemic has subsided, Golf Canada will review and potentially further modify selection criteria.

Introduction

This document outlines the criteria and process for selecting players to represent Canada in international amateur competition in 2021.

1. Prerequisites to selection

Players selected for international amateur competition must meet the following prerequisites:

- a. Must be a Canadian Citizen and hold a Canadian Passport (per the [IGF Nationality Policy](#)).
- b. Must be an amateur golfer under the Rules of Amateur Status.
- c. Must not be subject to any disciplinary process or sanction of Golf Canada.
- d. Must be in compliance with the Canadian Anti-Doping Policy (CADP).

2. International Events

Golf Canada may receive invitations to send players to international amateur events. Many events have been canceled for 2021. Should invitations be received, players will be selected based first on WAGR order and second on recent tournament results.
