Anniversary Golf Celebrations

What we typically facilitate is a team Scramble or a better-ball event. We provide our GHSC members who are dressed in period attire and play with authentic equipment. This is usually an 18-hole event followed by dinner. If so desired we can set up a display of golf antiques and memorabilia.

Options 1 and 2 below represent two approaches we can offer for events of this type.

Option 1 – Our membership participates with your club members. Your members are provided with loaner sets of hickory golf clubs. This can be set up in such a manner in order to meet your specific needs to accommodate 4-somes / 5-somes, etc. **There is No Cost to the Golf Course for this service.**

Option 2 – We send 4-6 of our members to act as ambassadors to sit at selected holes allowing your members to try hickory clubs. We provide the clubs. We typically also set up at your putting green. GHSC Ambassadors are supplied with food/beverages during the event and are permitted to return to the club at a later date to play your course. **The cost for this service is a \$500.00 donation to the GHSC.**

We can also provide a speaker prior to the commencement of each event. Suggested topics may include early golf at your facility, the roots of golf in Canada, and golfing with hickory equipment etc.

Your Members would have an opportunity to actually use century old Hickory Golf Clubs as well as be exposed to a quantity of exceptional and historic golf collectibles, some of which may have direct ties to your Golf Course and/or to your Course's early golf professional(s).

We would certainly do our best to accommodate any other ideas or suggestions that you might have. It is our hope that our participation might provide both a memorable and a very enjoyable event for your Members as well as a meaningful participatory experience in honour of your Course's Anniversary.
