



WORLD JUNIOR GIRLS CHAMPIONSHIP (2026) – SELECTION CRITERIA

Introduction: Herein are the criteria for selecting players to Team Canada at the World Junior Girls Championship (WJG) to be held at Brampton Golf Club in Brampton, ON from September 30 – October 3, 2026.

Team Composition: Team Canada 1 will be comprised of three players. Team Canada 2 will be comprised of three players. The Head Coach will decide which team (1 or 2) players compete on during the WJG.

Prerequisites:

- Must be a Canadian Citizen and hold a Canadian Passport (per the IGF Nationality Policy).
- Must be an amateur golfer under the Rules of Amateur Status.
- Must be in compliance with the Canadian Anti-Doping Policy (CADP).
- Must not be subject to any disciplinary process or sanction of Golf Canada or other sport authority.
- Participating athletes must be under 19 as of the last day of scheduled competition and must not be in university or college (CEGEP excluded).

Selection Criteria:

a. Automatic Selection (5 players):

- i. The top ranked player on WAGR with a minimum divisor of 15 as of August 26, 2026.
- ii. Winner of the 2026 Canadian Junior Girls Championship.
- iii. The top three players from the WJG Order of Merit (OOM) as of August 26, 2026.

b. Remaining Selection (1 player):

- i. Discretion of Golf Canada based on performance in recent competition and WAGR ranking as of August 26, 2026.

Declined selection(s) will be re-distributed at the discretion of Golf Canada until six players are selected to Team Canada for the WJG.

WJG OOM: Comprised of cumulative WAGR points earned in the following 2026 competitions.

- i. Canadian Junior Girls' Championship
- ii. Canadian Women's Amateur Championship
- iii. She Plays Golf (SPG) Championships
- iv. AJGA Invitationals
- v. U.S. Women's Amateur Championship
- vi. U.S. Girls' Junior
